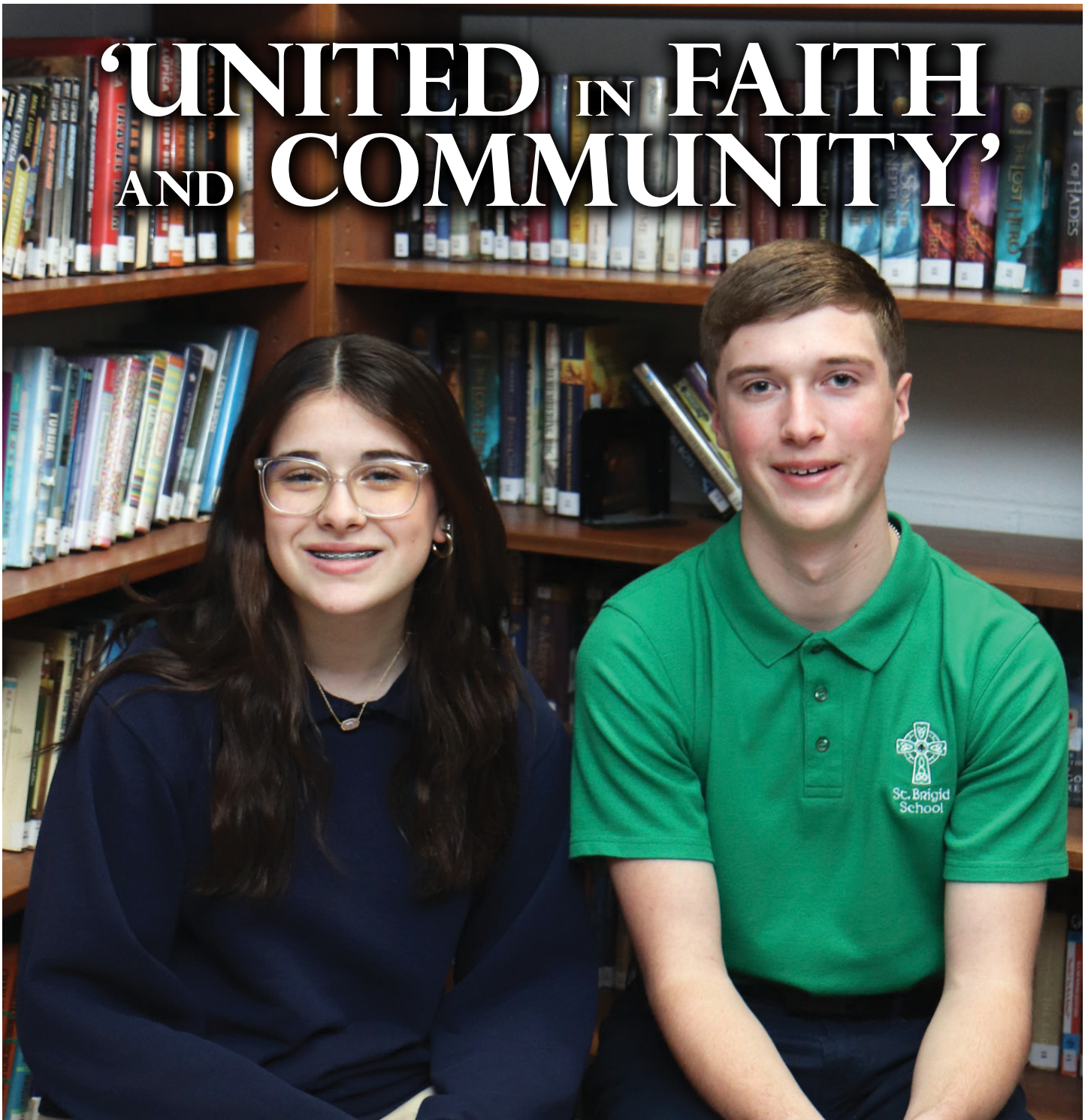

Today also begins Catholic Schools Week. Many thanks to the administrators and teachers in our schools for their excellent work in making disciples of the children of our parishes!

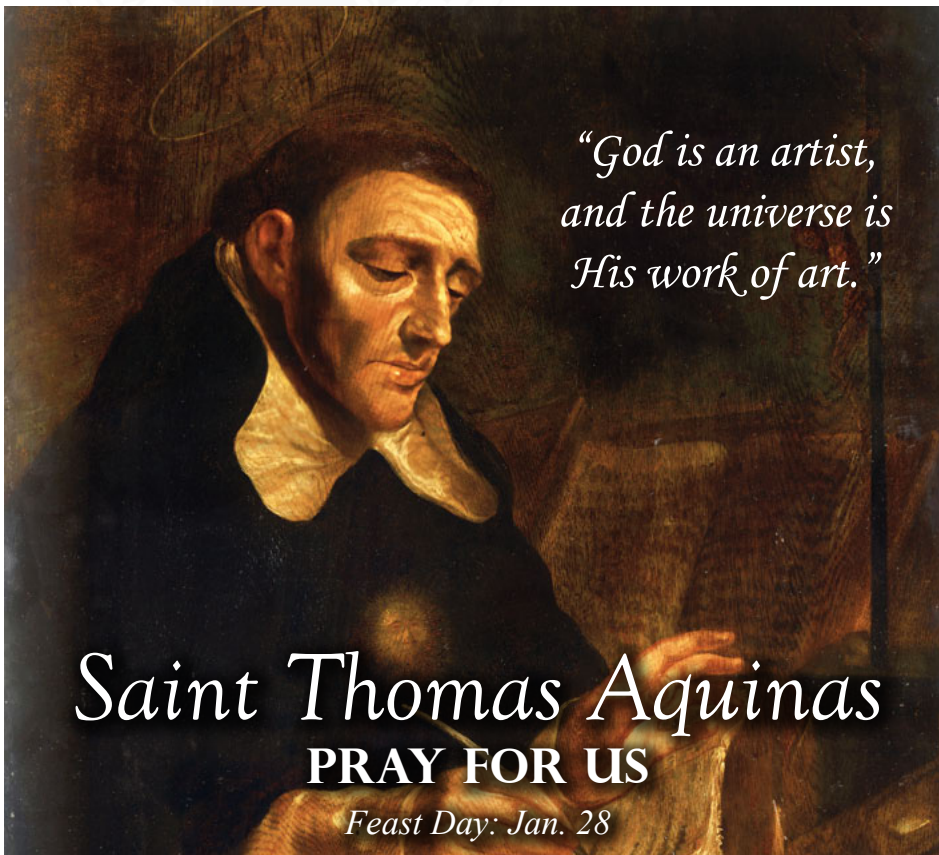
