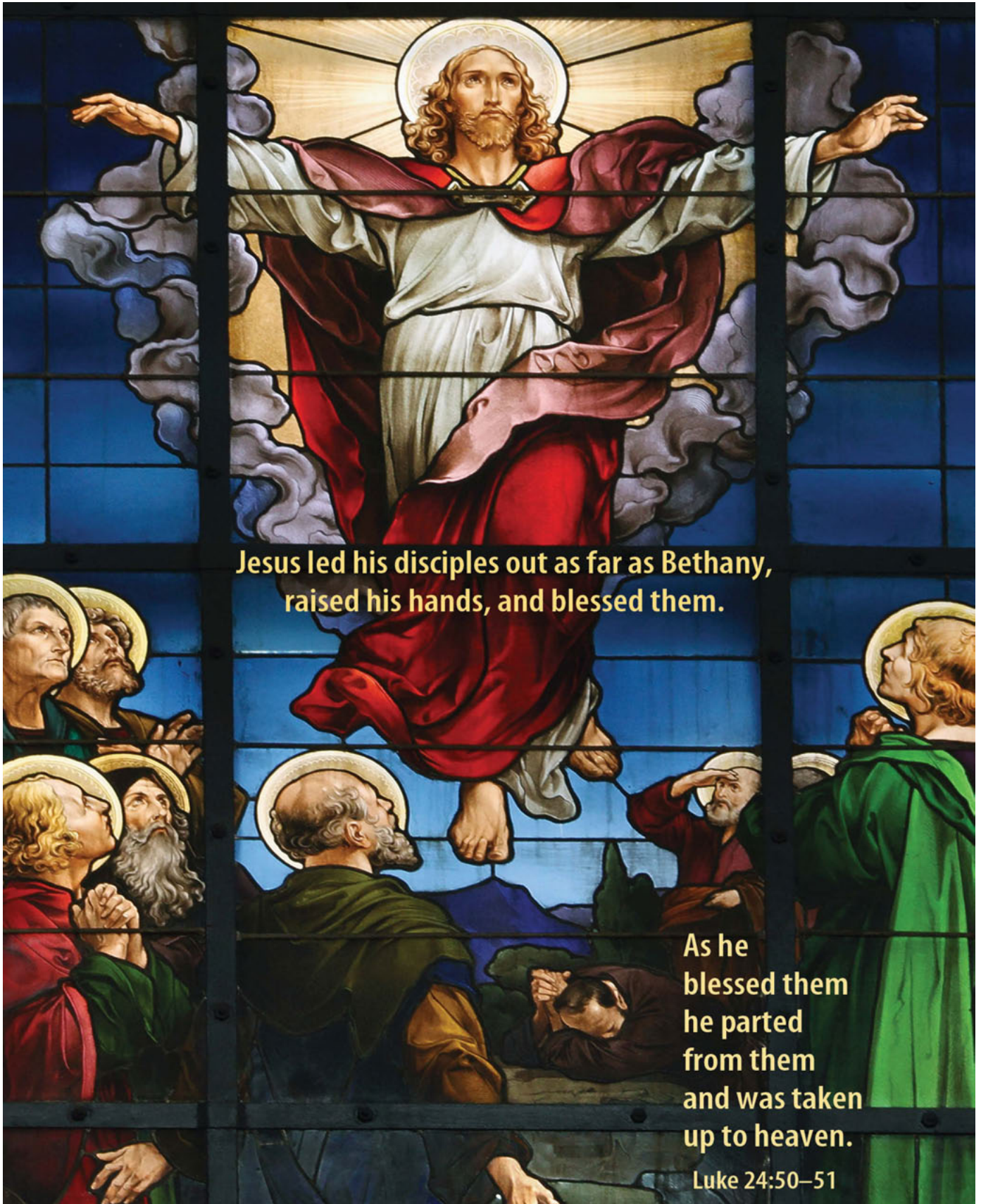

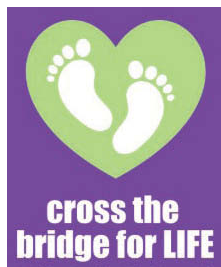

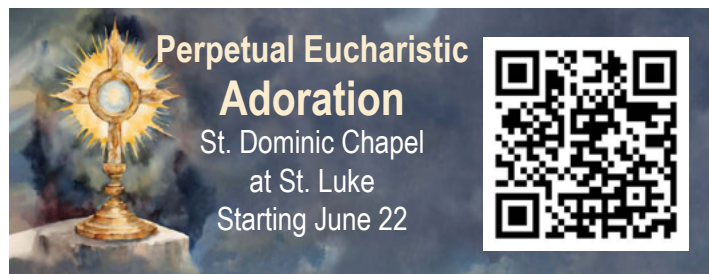
ST. MICHAEL FAMILY VBS TO START TOMORROW

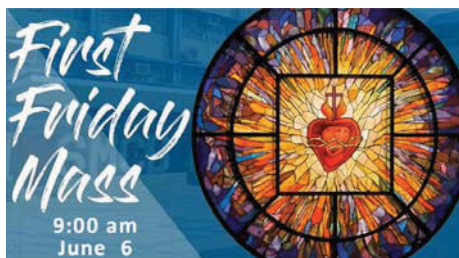

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion

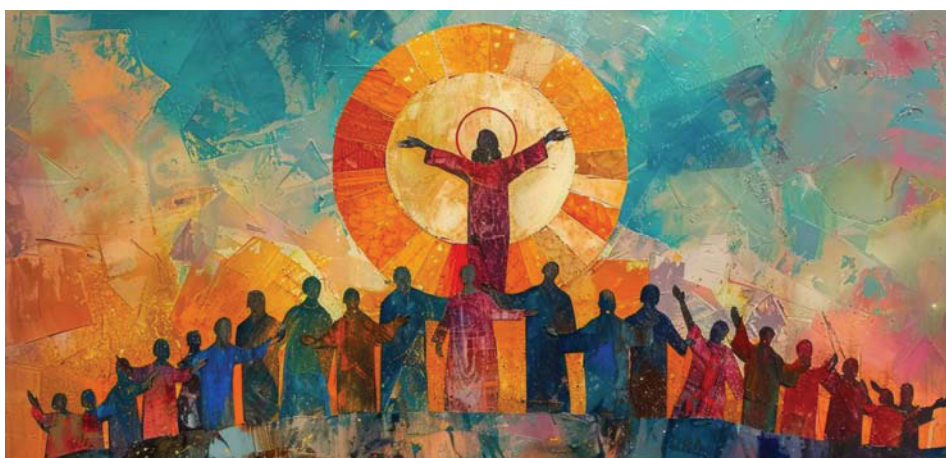

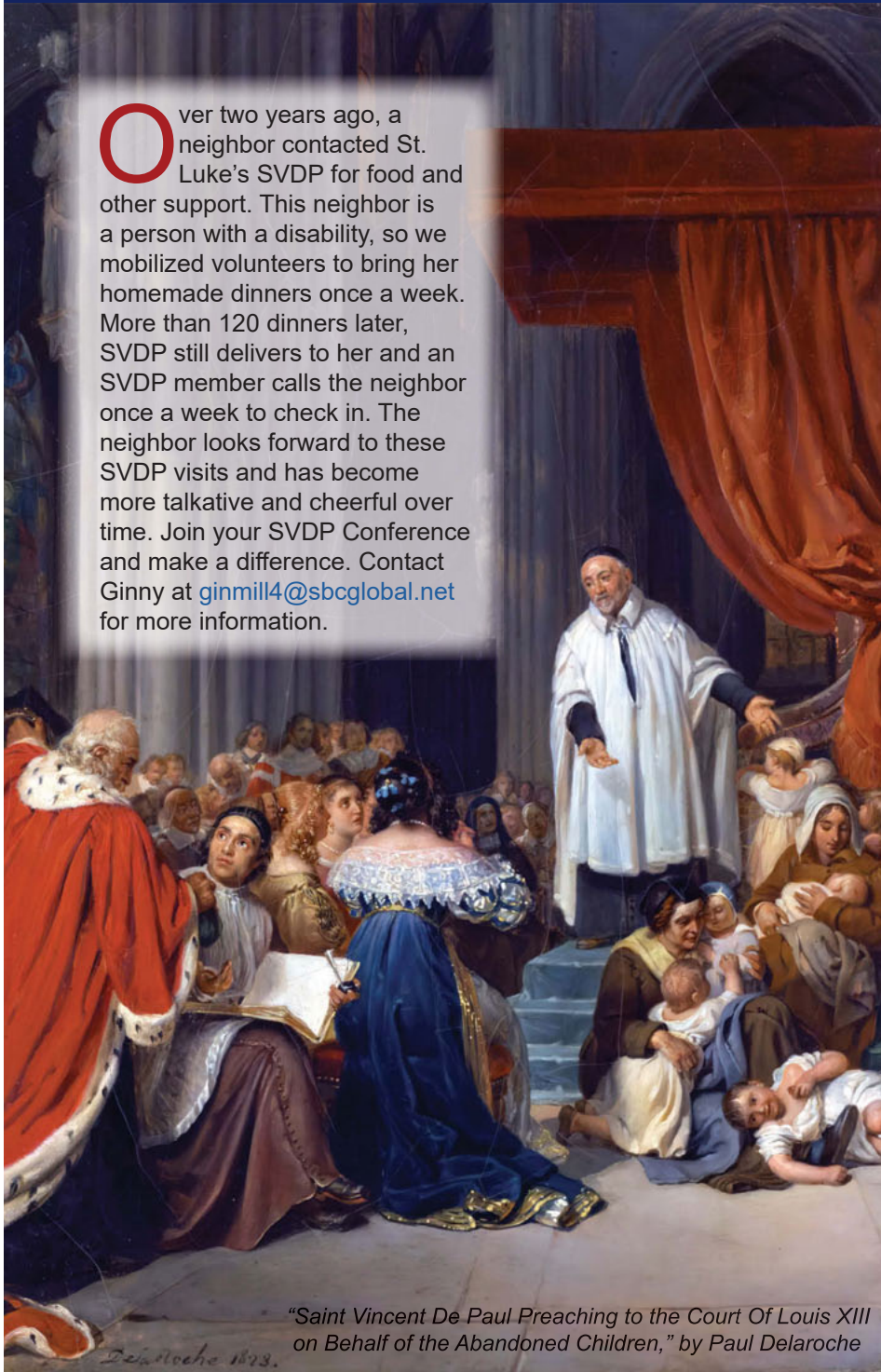

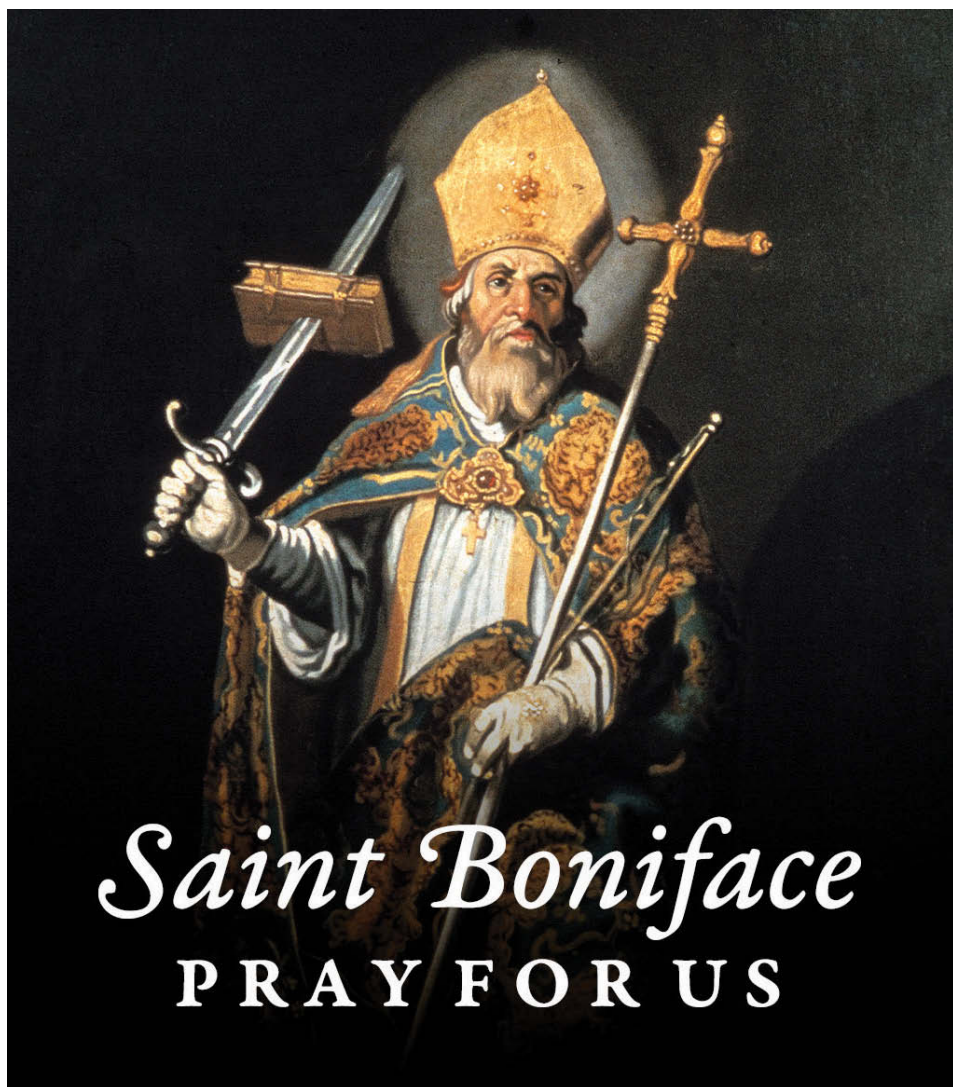
