


#### Most Sacred Heart of Jesus Feast Day



This year, we celebrate the 175th anniversary of St. Brigid Parish.

There will be various events throughout 2024 to commemorate this significant milestone. The celebration committee will also be providing a monthly "Did You Know" piece in the bulletin offering tidbits of information about the parish from its beginning in 1849 to present. We hope you learn some new and interesting history about the parish!

#### Did you know....

St. Brigid Church has a cemetery, located on West Second Street. The first parcel of land was bought in 1858. Jacob Klein, one of the

first Catholics to settle in Xenia, had purchased the land in 1844 and held it for a burial ground, until the new Catholic congregation could pay for it. The earliest graves date back to 1833, long before Jacob Klein acquired the land. These graves are believed to Catholics who were not allowed to be buried within the city limits due to anti-Catholic attitudes in Ohio at that time.

There is an outdoor altar, built in the 1960s, that is used for Mass on Memorial Day. Only two priests are buried in the cemetery. Fr. Thomas Blake, the first resident pastor, and Fr. Alphonse Schumacher, the fifteenth pastor, of St.Brigid Church. Fr. Schumacher is buried near the altar. In 2015, the addition of a columbarium as added for the cremated remains of the faithfully departed.
