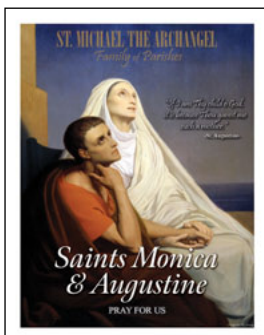

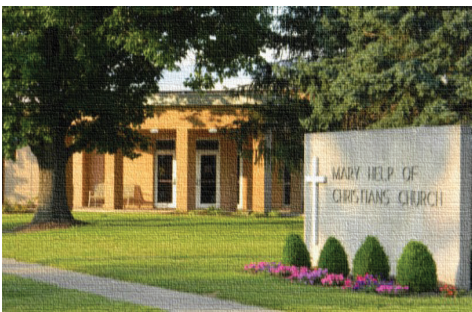

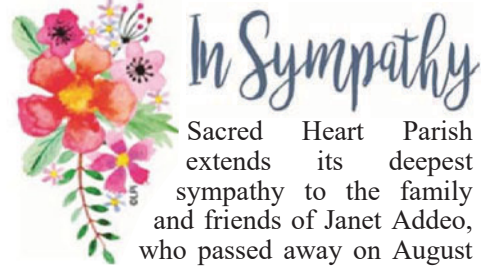

World Day for Grandparents

In 2021, Pope Francis established the celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly on the fourth

The U.S. bishops have approved the transfer of the celebration to the first weekend after Labor Day in September to coincide with National Grandparents Day in the United States as many local communities, schools, and parishes have celebrated for some time.

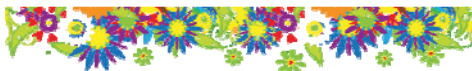

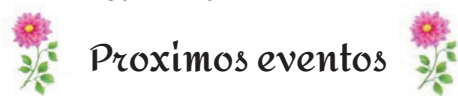

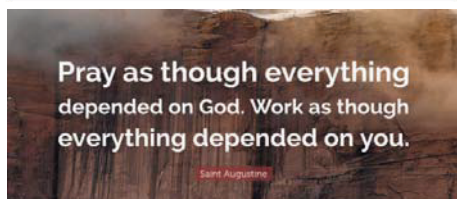
